Depending on the brewing schedule on the day of your tour, you may have access to some off-limit areas such as the Barrel Room. **Note:** Tour not available on Sundays.

The menu changes on a seasonal basis and includes local specialties and chef-inspired creations, such as baked stuffed shrimp with lobster and crab with tarragon sherry butter, grilled flat iron steak with roasted garlic and wild mushroom con fit, and Banana's Foster Tableside. Beers paired with each course will include Samuel Adams® beer and other East Coast favorites. Located at the Faneuil Hall Marketplace, adjacent to historic Faneuil Hall in the heart of Boston, McCormick & Schmick's is near the Boston Common, New England Aquarium, Old State House and Paul Revere's House.
