In personnel matters, the Board:

- employed Christine Olsen to fill a family medical leave of absence;
- accepted the resignations of teachers Kim Spry, Jennifer O'Neill, and Richard McGowan and lunchroom supervisor Karen Stevens; and
- granted the request for family medical leave of Kindergarten teacher Lauren Pasek.

In other business, the Board:

- gave direction to Superintendent Pain to offer before and after school day care services to district students from both Ivy League and the Frankfort Square Park District;
- heard a report about the music curriculum;
- heard a report concerning the Arbury Hills area utility work that will begin shortly;
- approved the purchase of materials with Illinois textbook loan allocations in the amount of \$32,298.76;
- authorized Administration to prepare the fiscal year 2009 Budget;
- accepted gifts from the Arbury Hills SCO in the amount of \$625, Summit Hill Junior High SCO gifts in the amount of \$3,805; Dr. Julian Rogus RESCO gifts in the amount of \$1,500, Indian Trail SCO gifts in the amount of \$3,335, Walker Intermediate School SCO gifts in the amount of \$8,223, Frankfort Square SCO gifts in the amount of \$2,425, and Tom Kaminski and RISO, Inc. for the gift of a maple tree in the amount of \$520; and
