Summit Hill School District 161's 2015-2016 Kindergarten registration drive is set for February 4 and February 5, 2015. Parents may access the Summit Hill website at www.summithill.org to review the checklist of documents needed for registration. Parents may register their child at Dr. Julian Rogus School, 20027 South 88th Ave. in Frankfort. Registration begins immediately following the 6 p.m. orientation program. Following completion of registration, students and parents may participate in a tour hosted by Rogus Kindergarten teachers. Parents have the option of enrolling their kindergartener in the extended day program which is from 8:45 a.m. to 2:15 p.m. or the half-day program which runs from 8:45 a.m. to 11:15 a.m. Registration fee for the extended day program is \$150. Registration fee for the half day program is \$125. Payment options are available. A \$20 off registration fee incentive is available for those who complete their child's registration on or before Feb. 27, 2015.

- will maintain the yearly cost for student milk at \$52.20 for the 2015-2016 school year;
- heard a preview of the January 16 Teacher Institute;
