## District schools earn ISBE's 2012 Illinois Honor Roll Academic Excellence Awards

Arbury Hills School, Frankfort Square School, and the former Mary Drew School earned the Illinois State Board of Education's 2012 Illinois Honor Roll Academic Excellence Awards. To earn the honor, schools must have made Adequate Yearly Progress in 2011 and 2012 as required by the No Child Left Behind Act. Additionally, 90 percent of students must have met or exceeded state standards in both reading and math for the three most recent school years.
