### **In personnel matters, the Board**

- accepted the resignation of Arbury Hills Principal Jeff Gerard effective June 30, 2013;
- accepted the resignation/retirement of Arliss Bouton effective June 30, 2013;
- accepted the resignations of Megan Shea, Kathryn Migely, and Catherine McNeil;
- employed Keri Snow, Wendy Webster, Regina Livingston, Karen Labeledz, Megan Shea, and Anna King as teachers for the 2013-2014 school year; and
- employed Catherine McNeil as secretary at Frankfort Square School.

### **In other matters, the Board**

- continued its discussion on class size guidelines to ensure that grade level average class sizes will be as balanced as possible within the schools and throughout the district;
- authorized administration to submit the general state aid entitlement claim, 2013 grants, and the annual claim for pupil transportation reimbursement for 2012-2013;
- confirmed the existence of hazardous transportation routes;
- adopted prevailing wage rates;
- approved the mulching contract with Bill's Lawn Maintenance;
- approved the asphalt maintenance contract with A.S.A.P. Asphalt Maintenance;
- approved the 2013-2014 Parent/Student Handbook
- approved the 2013-2014 Band Handbook
- approved the extension of the Cornerstone Lease Agreement;
