### **School and District Improvement Plans presented to the Board**

At its Sept. 23 meeting, members of the Board of Education heard presentations from administrators concerning the 2009-10 School Improvement Plans for each school as well as the District plan. The focus and goals of each School Improvement Plan are based on data from ISAT and NWEA assessments and student achievement results from 2008-2009.

### **Also at the meeting, the Board:**

- heard a report from Supt. Pain on the final ISAT test results for Summit Hill School District 161. Supt. Pain indicated that individual ISAT results will be distributed to parents on September 28.
- heard a presentation from Jr. High Math teacher Ryan Hagen concerning the Math Improvement and Math Applications courses that are being taught at Summit Hill Jr. High School;
- heard an overview from Music teacher Rita Binzen and her students on the new Guitar Class at Summit Hill Jr. High;
- heard a report from Board Members who attended a District 843 *Legal Issues* meeting;
- heard a report concerning the District 843 Special Education Meeting;
- heard that there currently are 3,685 students enrolled in District schools;
- authorized a part-time teacher to teach three additional term classes of study skills for the 2009-2010 school year; and
- approved the posting of the Administrators' Salary Compensation Report on the District web site.
