In personnel matters, the Board:

- accepted the retirement resignation of Arbury Hills Principal Pam Kohlbacher, effective July 1, 2010; and
- employed Meagan Weis as a kindergarten teacher for the 2010-11 school year.

In other matters, the Board:

- revised the last day of the 2009-10 school year to be May 27;
- approved the second reading of Board Policies 4:30, 4:60, 4:90, 4:110, 4:170, 5:20, 7:50, 8:30;
- adopted the Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) model of instruction for all schools beginning in the 2010-11 school year;
- accepted a gift from Mary Drew parent Mr. Gilligan in the amount of \$150;
- was made aware that the District met all state special educational performance requirements for 2008-2009 as required by the Individuals with Disabilities Act;
- was made aware that returning student online registration will begin May 3, 2010 and run through May 31, 2010; and
- was made aware that there are currently 3,683 students enrolled in district schools.
