In personnel matters, the Board:

- employed Frances Boss as a teacher for the 2010-2011 school year;
- employed Kaaren Bailey as a teacher for the 2010-2011 school year;
- employed Lauren Gatto as a teacher to fill a FMLA leave for a portion of the 2010-2011 school year;
- increased the Frankfort Square and Arbury Hills school nurse position to 6.5 hours; and
- approved a one-time 1% stipend for administrators and non-certified employees as identified by the Superintendent.

In other matters, the Board:

- acknowledged Summit Hill Jr. High student Kylie Tulloch for her State Champ title in discus. Kylie also finished 4th place in the shot put.
- authorized Administration to submit the general state aid entitlement claim, 2010-2011 grants, and the annual claim for pupil transportation reimbursement for 2009-2010;
- confirmed the existence of hazardous transportation routes;
- adopted prevailing wage rates;
- approved the Summit Hill Junior High School 8th Grade Washington Trip from April 15-17, 2011;
- accepted gifts from the Summit Hill Educational Foundation in the amount of \$31,940.58 and Walker SCO in the amount of \$10,676.87;
- heard an update on the Gifted Program;
- was informed that the July 4 holiday will be observed on July 5, 2010; and
- was informed that there currently are 3,682 students enrolled in district schools.
