Summit Hill School District 161 is diligent about ensuring our facilities are safe and healthy for students to learn. Part of ensuring a healthy learning environment is making sure our water sources are clean and safe for consumption. We want to emphasize and insure that we have clean, safe drinking water in your child's school.

In January 2017, the State of Illinois passed a new law requiring all public and private schools occupied by more than 10 students in grades pre-school through fifth grade to test all sources of potable water for lead content. All school buildings constructed before 1987 are required to be tested in 2017, and buildings built between 1987 and 2000 were or will be tested in 2018.

All known or potential potable drinking water sources were recently tested at Dr. Julian Rogus Elementary School. **We are pleased to announce that all potable drinking water sources at Dr. Julian Rogus Elementary School are in compliance with these regulatory requirements.**
