Health Screening Certification for Building Visitors

In accordance with guidance established by the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Illinois State Board of Education, schools and districts must monitor temperature and symptom screenings in an effort to keep students, staff and visitors entering buildings healthy and safe. Individuals who have a temperature greater than 100.4 degrees or currently known symptoms of COVID-19 such as fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, fatigue from an unknown cause, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestions or runny nose, nausea, abdominal pain from an unknown cause, diarrhea, or close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 or that had symptoms may not enter buildings.

Individuals who exhibit symptoms should be referred to a medical provider for evaluation, treatment and information about when they can return to the building.

All visitors must adhere to:

- Wearing a face mask when in the building
- Practice social distancing when in the building
- Sanitize hands upon entering and leaving the building
