On behalf of the Frankfort Square School staff, welcome to the 2021-2022 school year! We are excited for the start of the school year and cannot wait to see our students on August 25. As we continue to prepare for the first day of school, I want to highlight and share upcoming dates and information that pertain to the start of the school year.

Important Dates:

August 16 > PowerSchool is activated for our students and their families.

August 18 > A virtual tour of the building will be available (link to the video will be sent at a later date).

August 19 > Supply Drop-off at FSS from 7:00 AM – 5:00 PM. For additional information, see below.

August 23 & 24 > Staff In-service Days

August 25 > First Day of School for Students (full day)

Supply Drop-off Information:

On August 19, from 7:00 AM – 5:00 PM, Frankfort Square School will be open for our students to drop-off their supplies and become familiar with the building. To sign-up for a time slot, please visit:

Please note the following:

*Teachers may not be available during the August 19 Supply Drop-off date.

*Tables will be set up outside the classrooms for the students to drop-off their supplies.

*To adhere to social distancing protocols, only FSS students and one adult per family may enter the building during the 30-minute time slot.

*The Supply Drop-off event is optional. If your child is unable to attend, please feel free to have your child bring her/his supplies to school during the first few days of school.

School Day Arrival Process:

Similar to last school year, we will open the doors around 8:45 AM to allow the students to enter the school. In doing so, we hope to limit the number of students congregating outside the building. If you plan to drive your child to school, please do not park your vehicle in the main arrival lane. Rather, when you enter the parking lot, pull forward as far as you can. We will have staff waving the vehicles forward. When your child enters the building, we will have staff available to help your child find her/his classroom. We will continue this practice throughout the school year!

School Day Dismissal Process:

Similar to last year, we will have separate areas for students who walk home, ride the bus, or will be a car rider. If you plan on picking up your child in a vehicle, please make sure that you have your child's name and teacher's name on a sheet of paper. Place the sheet of paper on the passenger side window. We will use this information to dismiss your child from the building. Students who plan on walking home will be dismissed via Door 1. Students who take a bus will be dismissed to their bus under the supervision of several of our staff members.
