

Walker Families:

Below is information pertaining to Hilda Walker's academic and behavioral support programs offered throughout the year. Please read below to find out more:

ACADEMIC ASSISTANCE (AA):

1. Monday thru Thursday (except 1st Tuesday of every month and/or the day before a holiday) after school from 2:55pm-3:55pm.
2. Students can only attend AA if they have a completed AA pass and have parent approval or if the students have been placed by an administrator. Students are expected to bring all work and materials needed to complete assignments with assistance if needed. If you would like to request to have your child attend AA, please begin by contacting their homeroom teacher.
3. Academic Assistance is not a homework club, per se. It is a time for students to get the assistance they may need in a specific subject area.
4. Behavioral expectations are consistent with the Walker Way. If students do not follow appropriate academic/behavioral expectations, they will not be able to utilize Academic Assistance.

STUDY HALL (SH)/TURNABOUT (TA):

1. Monday thru Friday during the complete lunch/intramural period.
2. SH is a time for students to make up assessments, complete unfinished assessments, and late or missing assessments. This is not an opportunity for students to complete their homework.
3. TA is a mandated program for students who fail a course during any quarter. Once a student enters the TA program, if they receive a D or an F on any assignment/assessment, or if they have a missing or incomplete assignment, they will be sent to TA to make up or complete the necessary corrections.
4. Turnabout is slated to begin second quarter. The supervising teacher is expected to help the student with the material as needed. If a student does not finish the assignment, the assignment will be sent home. All completed work should be turned into the referring teacher the next day.

DETENTION (DT):

1. Lunch Detention will be scheduled by staff or administration for students who have received one or two minor referrals. Lunch DT will be held during the complete lunch/intramural period daily. If the violation relates to incomplete assessments, the student will be expected to complete the specific assessment after completing the behavioral reflection sheet.
2. After-school Detentions will be scheduled by staff or administration for students who have received one or more major referrals. After-school DT will be held after school on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday weekly (except 1st Tuesday of every month and/or the day before a holiday). Staff and Administration will contact parents for permission for the child to stay after school before they serve the detention. If the violation relates to repeated incomplete assessments, the student will be expected to complete the specific assessment after completing the behavioral reflection sheet.

PINK Incomplete/Late/Missing Assessment Notice:

These notices are mandatory and are completed with each missing assessment a student may have.

Students who receive three notices will be issued a minor referral resulting in a lunch detention. Students who receive three minor referrals will then be issued a major referral resulting in an after-school detention on the third notice violation. Each quarter students will begin with a clean slate.
