Board of Education reviews Gifted/Honors Program

At Wednesday night's meeting of the Summit Hill Board of Education, members agreed to modifications on how services are delivered within the District's Gifted/Honors Program. The review follows a year-long study of the current program by a committee of parents, teachers, and administrators. Content area staff who have taken gifted education seminars will continue to be responsible for instruction. Jim Martin, assistant superintendent, will oversee school-based support and implementation of the program.
