In personnel matters, the Board:

- accepted a letter of resignation from Jamie Voss, effective the last day of the 2010-11 school year; and
- employed Kathryn Bryan as a paraprofessional.

In other matters, the Board:

- acknowledged the Mary Drew School students who have excelled in a recent math contest;
- acknowledged the Summit Hill Junior High Competition Cheerleaders for taking 1st place at the IESA State Championship Competition;
- heard a report of the District Improvement Team and District Excellence Team;
- approved registration fees for 2011-2012 school year for half-day kindergarten and preschool programs to remain at \$125; for grades K-8 to remain at \$150; and the late fee to remain at \$25;
- approved the mileage reimbursement to be 51 cents/mile; and
- noted there currently are 3,584 students enrolled in district schools.
