- employed Alexandria Cialdella as a lunchroom supervisor; and
- approved a request for a family medical leave extension.

In other matters, the Board:

- recognized Summit Hill Concert Band, Symphonic Band and Spartan Singers along with Walker students Kelly Prusak and Ibrahim Jody who were chosen as the D.A.R.E. essay winners;
- acknowledged District staff whose names were presented to the Illinois State Board of Education for recognition in the Those Who Excel Awards Program. District nominees are Tina Prorok, Frankfort Square School, Student Support Personnel category; Martin Acevedo, Walker School, Classroom Teacher category; Barb Rains, Administrative Center, Administrator category; and Kim Coughlin, Catherine Goddard, Jason Collins, and Scott Wagstaff in the Team category;
- approved the amended FY 2011 District 161 Budget;
- relocated the Pre-Kindergarten Program to Frankfort Square School;
