Covid-19 Decision Matrix-Symptoms and Positive Tests

Scenario	Vaccination Status	Action	Duration	Return to School Requirements
Covid-like Symptoms	Not applicable	Stay home. Families should follow standard procedures to report student absence at each building.	Stay home until you are symptom free for 24 hours and have a negative PCR test or rapid test from a licensed facility. OR Stay home for 5 days from onset of symptoms with no test.	Provide negative PCR test or rapid test from a licensed facility. If not being tested, remain at home and report student absence for the 5 days. It is recommended to wear a mask for 5 more days when around others upon return.
Individual tests positive	Not applicable	Stay home. Families should follow standard procedures to report student absence at each building.	5 Days Day 0 is test date if no symptoms were present. If symptoms were present when test specimen sample was collected, Day 0 is symptom onset date.	May return when fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication, 24 hours of diarrhea or vomiting ceasing, and other symptoms, such as sore throat or cough have improved. It is recommended to wear a mask for 5 more days when around others upon return. Follow recommended school mitigation guidelines.

Covid-19 Decision Matrix-Close Contacts

Scenario	Vaccination Status	Action	Duration	Return to School Requirements
Close contact to positive individual	Unvaccinated	<p>If it is a school exposure, the school office will notify families if their child was considered a close contact to a COVID-positive individual.</p> <p>It is recommended that the individual stay home 5 days from the last day of exposure, but it is not required.</p> <p>If it is exposure from outside of the school or within the home, it is recommended that the student should remain at home 5 days from the last day of exposure, but it is not required.</p> <p>In all situations, if close contact develops symptoms, it is recommended they test for COVID or would need to stay at home for five days from onset of symptoms.</p> <p>Families should follow standard procedures to report student absence at each building.</p>	If close contact is quarantining, it is recommended they remain at home for 5 days: The day of last exposure is Day 0.	<p>If choosing to quarantine, individual must be symptom free.</p> <p>If symptoms are present and individual has chosen to quarantine, continue to stay home and follow Covid-like symptoms scenario.</p> <p>Follow recommended school mitigation guidelines.</p>
Close contact to positive individual	<p>Vaccinated students, even those not eligible for booster yet</p> <p>Confirmed positive test within the last 90 days</p>	No school exclusion unless symptoms are present.	Monitor for symptoms for 10 days.	<p>Submit a copy of student vaccination card.</p> <p>Continue to follow recommended required school-based mitigations.</p>
