Regular attendance is important for success in school. Please ensure that your children are at school early enough to be in their classroom by 9:00 when school begins.

VISITORS

We encourage family participation, volunteering, and welcome your assistance. For the safety of our students and staff, all visitors must sign in at the main office. Please have a driver's license or state ID available when you check in at the office.

During arrival and dismissal times, please be aware of children, their families, and staff in the crosswalks. Please look for the flashing lights and stop signs of the school buses. Please remind your child to walk her/his bike when on the school's sidewalks. At all times, children are to be supervised by an adult when in the parking lot.
